

RE: Winterizing Your Irrigation System

Your irrigation system is equipped with a RPZ which is a device that prevents the non-portable water from your irrigation system mixing with the portable water to your home. It is important during periods of freezing or below freezing temperatures that you follow the steps in the photo below to drain the RPZ valve to keep it from freezing and possibly bursting. Turn water off at the ball valve which is in a box next to the RPZ. Take a small flathead screwdriver and open the 4 test cocks to drain the water from the RPZ, leave water off during freezing temperatures. To turn system back on close the test cocks and turn the valve back on.
